# ON JUNE 11<sup>TH</sup> 2005, INTERNATIONAL YOUNG EAGLES DAY, 10,000 YOUNGSTERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 8 AND 17 WILL RECEIVE A FREE AIRPLANE RIDE

EAA AVIATION CENTER, OSHKOSH, Wis. - (April 11, 2005) - Thousands of young people will take to the sky on Saturday, June 11, as EAA volunteers continue an outstanding aviation tradition - International Young Eagles Day. The annual event brings together kids and pilots as part of the EAA Young Eagles program, the largest youth aviation education program ever created, which has flown more than 1.1 million young people free of charge since its inception in July 1992.

A pilot and each Young Eagle conduct a preflight check of an airplane, focusing on how the airplane works and how pilots prepare to fly safely. They then board the aircraft and take a brief (5-20 minute) flight, where young people can discover more about the aircraft and the unique perspective from the sky. Following the flight, each Young Eagle receives a certificate signed by the pilot, and also has his or her name entered in the "World's Largest Logbook," which is on permanent display at the EAA AirVenture Museum and through the <a href="www.youngeagles.org">www.youngeagles.org</a> web site.
