

Worcester Area Pilots Association Aviation Scholarship Application Process

## **Requirements for Eligibility**

- Candidate must be age 16 to 21
- Candidate should be an active student in high school or college.
- Candidate should reside within 25 miles of Worcester, however college students who would meet the residency requirements except while attending college away from home are still eligible.
- Candidate must posses:
  - Student Pilot and Medical Certificate
  - Proof of a passing grade on the Private Pilot written exam

## **Application Process**

- Candidate submits full application and essay
- · Candidate submits proof of grades and student standing
- Recommendations from a teacher and/or flight instructor will be considered if provided..
- A WAPA member interviews candidate
- Scholarship committee selects candidate(s) to award scholarship

## **Post-award process**

- WAPA assigns a WAPA member to mentor (AOPA mentor-style) the student
- A flight school or instructor is selected
- Scholarship committee/mentor monitors student progress.
- Students are required to show proof of training by presenting signed log books.
- Student submits receipts for instruction and aircraft rental to WAPA for reimbursement up to the limit of the scholarship award.
- Reimbursement is made on a 1 for 2 basis. WAPA reimburses 1 hour for each 2 hours flown.
- Flight training received as part of a program of higher education is also eligible.
- Student must continue to maintain grades in good standing to be eligible for continued reimbursement
- All Scholarship applicants are eligible to re-apply in subsequent years, except:
  - Any applicant to be found to have: falsified the application; not written their own essay; or submitted false receipts or any other false information, shall be barred from any future consideration
- In the event of a dispute, the WAPA Board of Directors shall have the final authority.
